To announce trainings scheduled for October 2019 that will provide high level overviews of the ODP Regulation Package.

The Office of Developmental Programs (ODP) is pleased to announce that it is releasing a number of trainings that help to explain updates to regulations affecting individuals with intellectual disabilities or autism. The ODP Regulation Package published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* on October 5, 2019, represents the most dramatic changes in the past 30 years to our service system. The trainings scheduled for October are structured to help stakeholders understand the major changes and how they impact the system. More trainings are in development on specific topics and requirements contained in the ODP Regulatory Package. ODP will send updates to this announcement as new trainings pertaining to the ODP Regulatory Package are offered.
