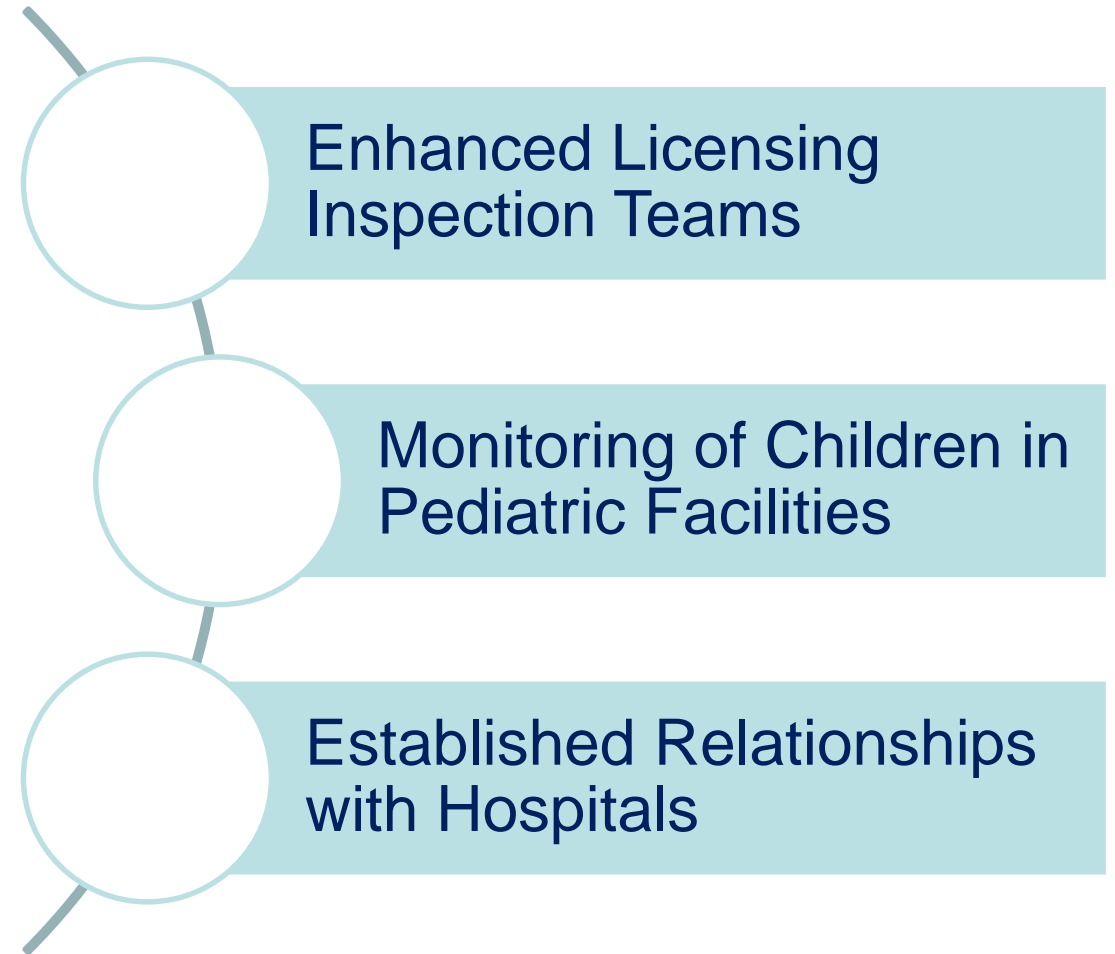
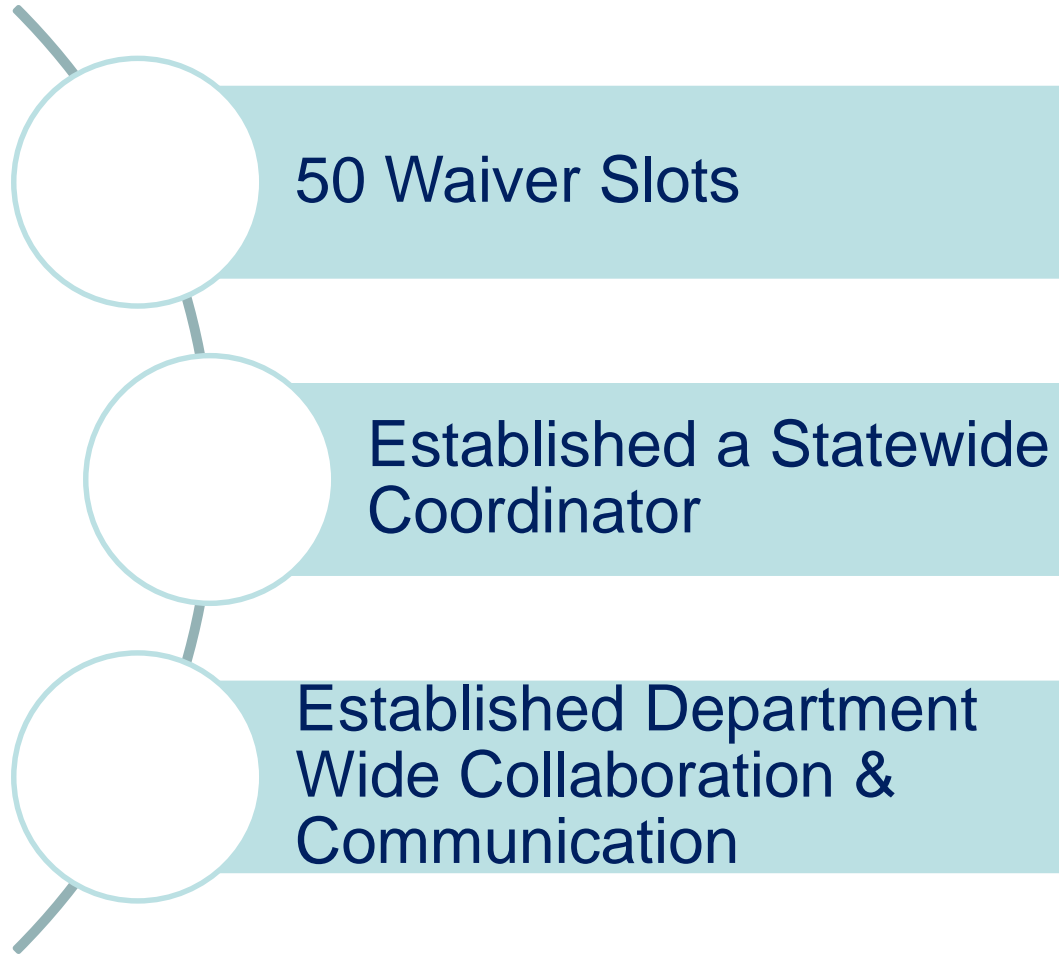


Ensure the health and welfare of children in facilities

DHS Accomplishments



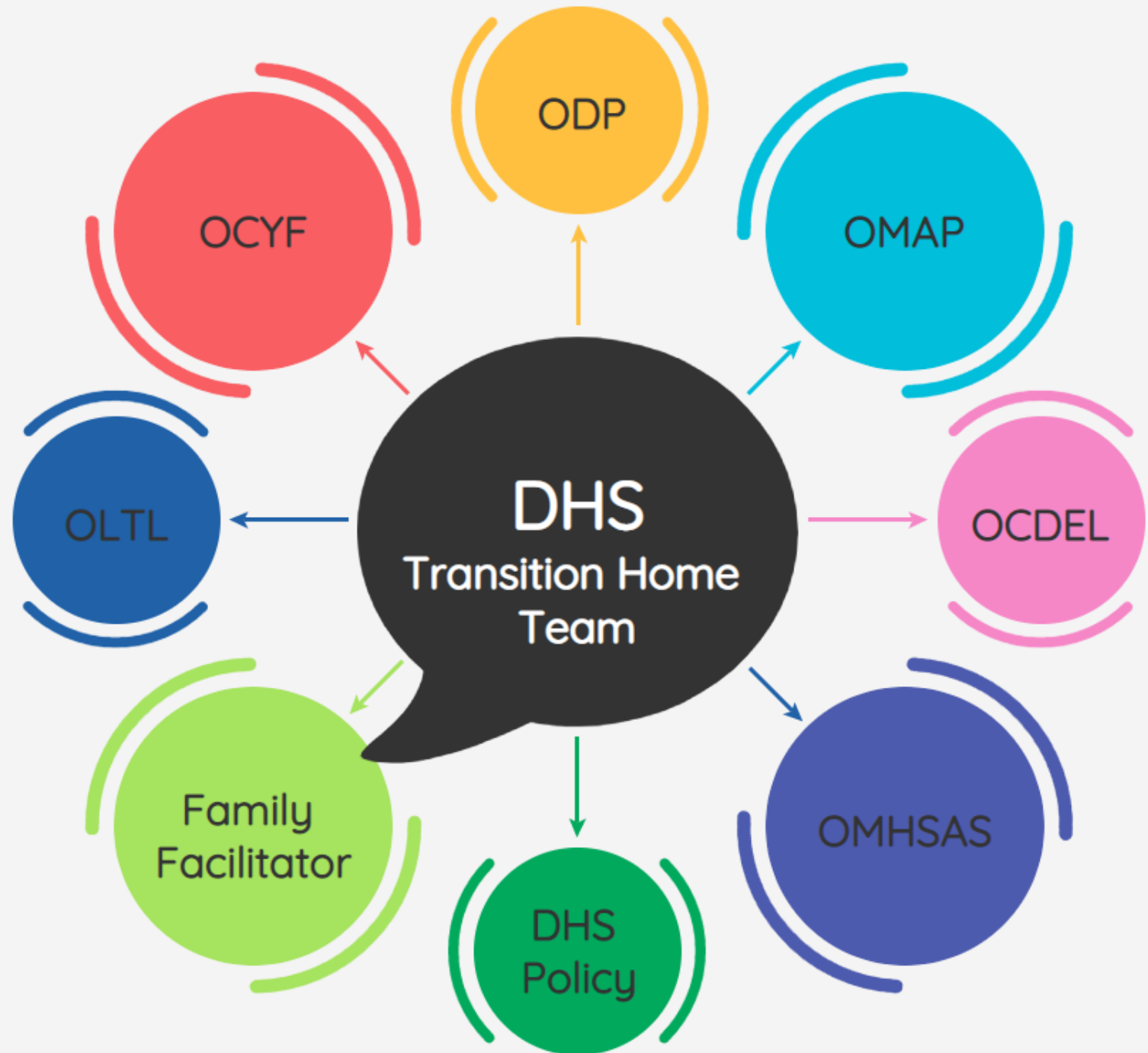
Family Facilitator

- **Work with families** to assist in planning for their child's return home from the hospital or residential facility.
- **Work with the child's system of care** including facilities, hospitals, physicians, the managed care organization, the early intervention program, county CYF, county ID/A programs and providers to plan for ongoing supports to the family.

What we learned in 2020:

Children in Pediatric Facilities:

- Roughly 227 children living in facilities
- Roughly 47% have lived there for less than 3 years
- Roughly 42% have lived there between 3-10 years
- Roughly 11% have lived there longer than 10 years

Admissions:

- Less than 40 admissions in 2020
- Half were from hospitals (most under the age of 5) and
- Half were from family homes or foster homes (most over age 5)

Discharges:

- Less than 40 discharges in 2020
- The shorter the stay and the younger the child, the more likely the child will go home.
